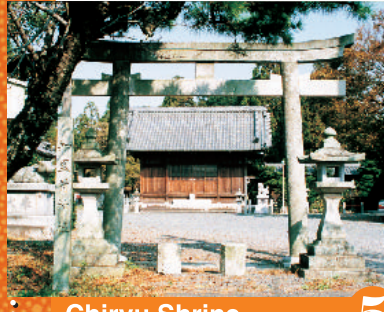
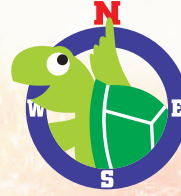

5 Chiryu Shrine

The "Unopenable Box"—which is said to be the *Tamabako* that Urashima Taro brought back from Ryugu Palace—is carefully stored here. (Closed to the public.) They've also enshrined the "Urashima Shrine" here.

6 Shinrakuji Temple

There is the tomb of the turtle, which was helped by Urashima Taro.

4 Urashima Bridge

Urashima Taro went to Ryugu Palace with the turtle along the river passing under this bridge.



3 Obugame Pine trees

The turtle, which Urashima Taro saved, was living here. In those days, there was a white sandy beach and a thick woods of pine trees. The name of the place, "Fuki" was once called "Obugame" (It means "The turtle carries the man")



2 Otohime bridge

They say that this is the place where Princess Otohime met Urashima Taro.



1 Ryugu Shrine

Urashima Taro established this shrine in memory of Princess Otohime in DC 825.

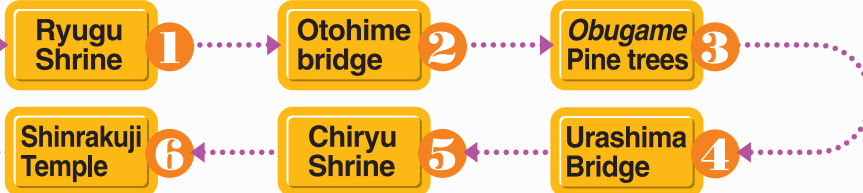

Possible Courses For Walkers

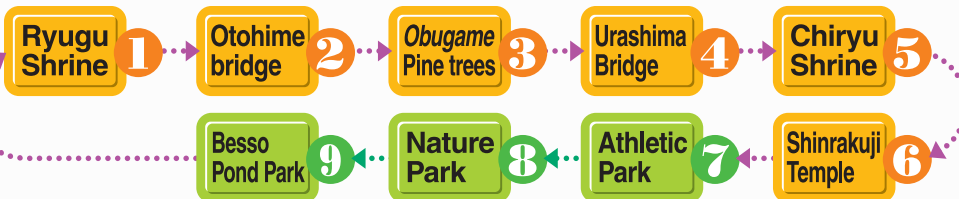
Historic Site Course
